



Eastbound from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) – 12/15/25 update

Swire Shipping Lines is providing advance notice of a peak season surcharge effective January 1, 2026, applicable to all Eastbound cargoes from Japan, Korea and China to the U.S. and Canada. This change applies to all commodities moving under contract and tariff rates and is based on the date of cargo receipt at B/L origin.
