Eastbound from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada

Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) – 1/14/2026 update

Swire Shipping Lines is providing advance notice of a peak season surcharge effective **January 15, 2026**, applicable to all Eastbound cargoes from Japan, Korea and China to the U.S. and Canada. This change applies to all commodities moving under **contract and tariff rates** and is based on the date of cargo receipt at B/L origin.

Japan origins to all U.S. and Canadian Ports/Points

Effective July 15, 2025:
