Eastbound from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada

Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) – 05/30/25 update

Swire Shipping Lines is providing advance notice of a peak season surcharge effective **July 1, 2025**, applicable to all Eastbound cargoes from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada. This change applies to all commodities moving under **contract and tariff rates** and is based on the date of cargo receipt at B/L origin.
