

## Eastbound from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada

## General Rate Increase – 05/15/2024 Canceled

Swire Shipping is providing advance notice of a general rate increase effective **May 15, 2024,** applicable to all Eastbound cargoes from Japan, Korea, and China to the U.S. and Canada. This change applies to all commodities moving under **contracts** and **tariff rates** and is based on the date of cargo receipt at B/L origin.
