General Rate Increase (GRI) – 01/13/2022

UPDATE

December 15, 2021

Dear Valued Customer:

Westwood Shipping Lines is providing advance notice of a General Rate Increase (GRI) effective January 13, 2022, applicable to all Westbound cargoes from the U.S. and Canada to Japan, Korea, and China. This will include all unit types (Reefers included), both IPI and local, both the U.S. and Canada origins. This change applies to all commodities moving under Service Contracts, Freight Agreements, or Tariff rates and is based on the date of cargo receipt at B/L origin:

U.S and Canada origins to Tomakomai & Hitachinaka, Japan, and all feeder outport destinations

Effective January 13, 2022:	USD
20' - all equipment types, designated by size only	\$850 per container
40' - all equipment types, designated by size only	\$1,000 per container
40HC' - all equipment types, designated by size only	\$1,000 per container

U.S and Canada origins to Japan Base Ports (including Shimizu & Hakata), and Pusan, Korea
